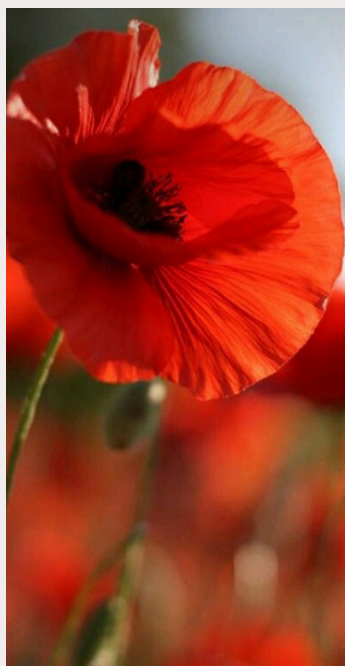
Belionel is a tribute to the arts through fashion, a revival of legends where femininity and passion resonate in every piece.

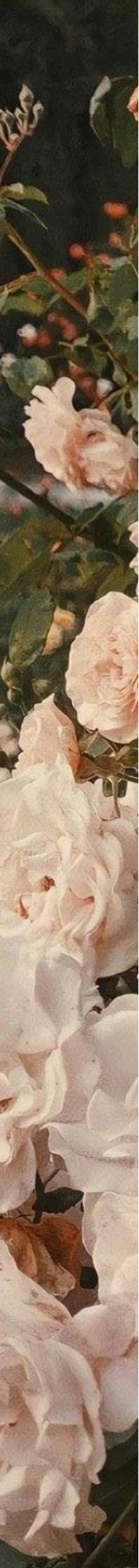

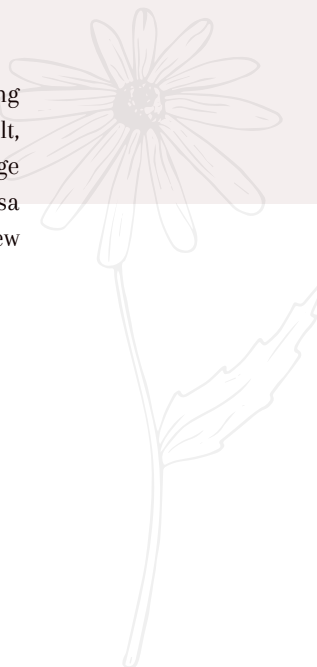

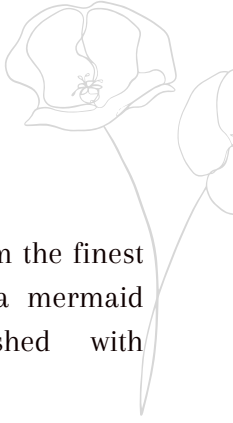
Rosa Top Gloriosa Pants
